Fall Semester 2020 Operational Plan

- Teach smaller classes in multiple sections, extending hours into the evening.
- Half of each class attends in person one day while the other half does so online, then flip the next day
- Move classes into larger spaces, including auditoriums and fitness center.
- Purchase more outdoor furniture to meet in open space during good weather.
- Lease nearby apartments/secure additional housing to allow single rooms.
- Group students in clusters and limit close contact with those on other floors.
- Install hand sanitizer stations at the entrance of each residence hall.
- Provide each student with a health kit with a thermometer, mask, gloves, Tylenol and Gatorade.
- Provide a range of dining options including take-out meals only or eating in cafeterias with social distancing guidelines.
- Availability of COVID testing required before students return to campus.
- Develop methods for contact tracing, possibly electronic.
- Older faculty and staff may continue to work from home remotely.
- Priority given to senior students to return to campus to keep them on track for graduation.
- Also priority to freshmen/transfer students so they get the on-campus experience.
